This program invites art students from our area high schools to participate in this huge clay project that when finished will be 11 feet long and 5 feet tall ... it is called ***Imagine Florida!***

This is an opportunity for serious art students to work with a professional artist and see what it takes to be a professional artist. Jan will work with the students on every phase of the sculpture each Saturday for 10 to 12 weeks during February, March, and April. Students must pre-register to participate in AIR 2012. Space is limited.

This will be the second time Jan has been invited to be CSMART's Artist in Residence. In 2004 she and John Foster created the impressive 7,000 tile Ceramic Relief Tile Mural called the **Everglades**.
