The discussion will focus on the hallmarks used by the women silversmiths in the current Museum exhibition *British Women Silversmiths: Private Collection of 17th to 19th Century Pieces*. A hallmark or makers is a marking that is stamped into silver work, signifying the various guilds "Halls" where the silversmith was associated, as well as, the mark of the silversmith, the date the piece was created and the purity content of the piece.
