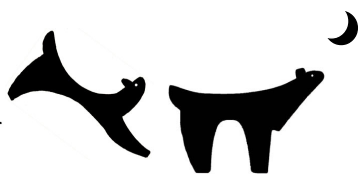

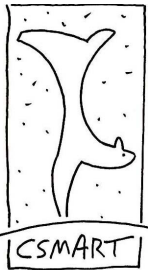

- **Class fees cannot be pro-rated and are non-refundable.** No fees will be returned for failure to attend. A \$10 processing fee will be assessed for cancellation of class.
- **Museum Members** save \$15 each time they register for a class.
- **Monet Level Members** (and above) also receive an additional 10% discount per class.
- **\$5 sibling discount**, pay full price for the first child and all other siblings receive \$5 off their class.
- **There is a \$30 charge** for all returned checks.
